Installation 2021-2023 of three new state-of-the-art C-band weather radars in Iceland, replacing two old ones

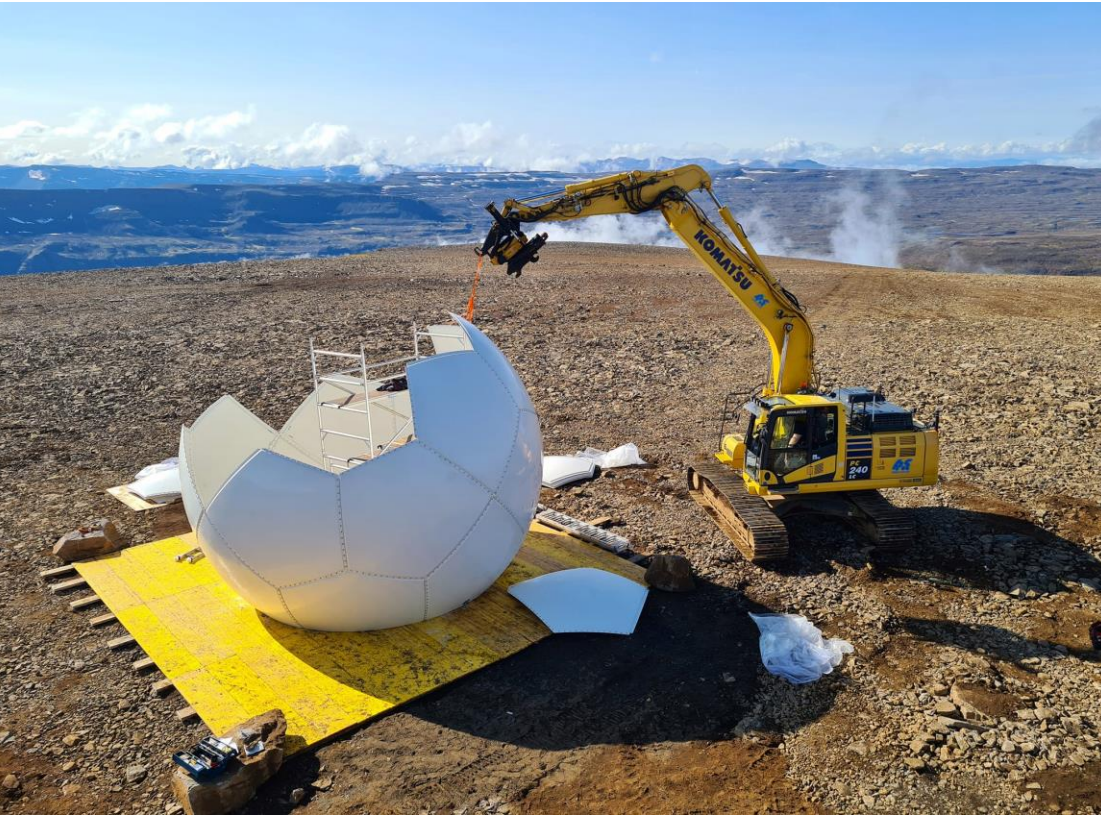
Leonardo Meteor 735CDP10

- **Sept 2023** **Bjólfur – isbjo new site**
 - 65.2659°N, 14.0618°W, 1090 m asl.



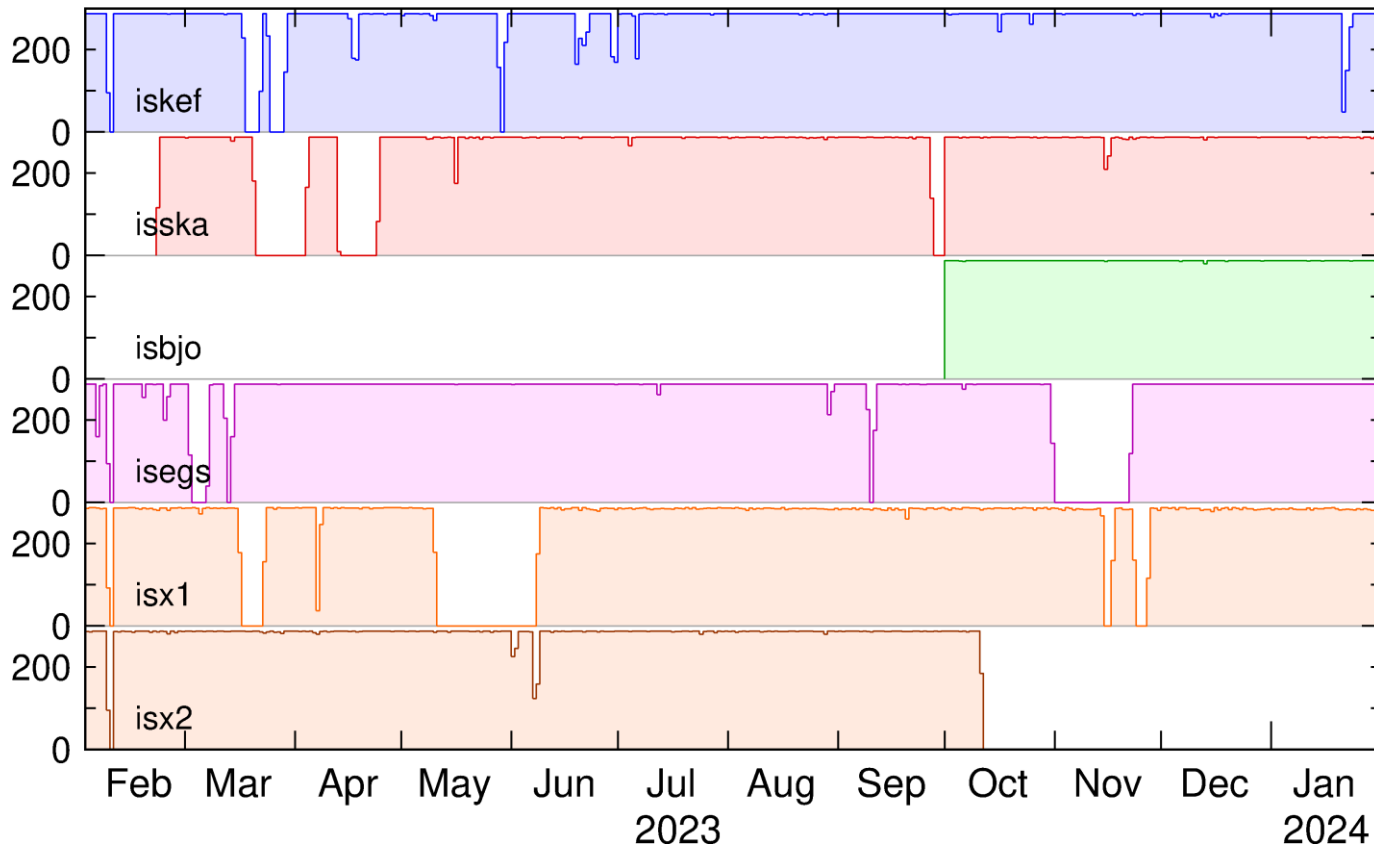
Bjölfur - isbjo – new radar, E-Iceland
